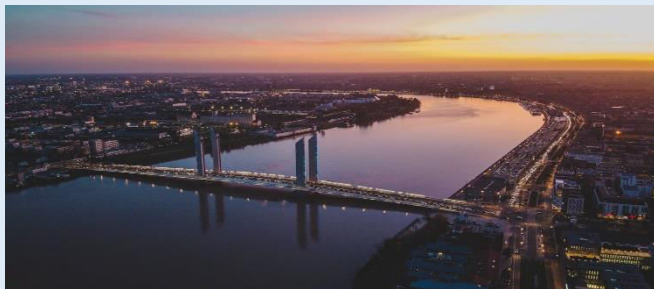




ARMED FOR THE MARKET

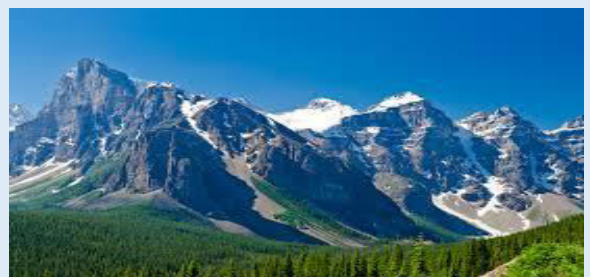
