True peace in business is the confidence that your public success is built on a private foundation of integrity. When you protect the standard, God protects the peace.

- ✓ **Protect the Brand:** Identify your company's "sacred" value (e.g., radical honesty). Publicly reward a team member who upheld this value, even when it was inconvenient.
- ✓ **Legacy Thinking:** Before signing your next contract, ask: "Does this deal reflect the 'lasting priesthood' I want to build, or is it just a quick fix?"
