2 Chronicles 17

King Jehoshaphat stepped into power with a bold choice. He did not lean on his own strength. He sought the God of his father David. He walked in the first ways. He did not chase after local idols. His heart took delight in the ways of the Lord. He removed the high places and the false altars from Judah.



You lead a modern enterprise. Your boardroom is your modern Judah. The market offers a thousand hidden idols today. It whispers of cut corners, fear-based margins, and self-reliance. Jehoshaphat shows us a better path. Under the New Covenant, you do not fight for victory. You lead from a place of finished victory. Christ is your cornerstone. When your heart takes delight in His truth, fear loses its vote in your strategic planning. Jehoshaphat did something radical. He sent leaders, Levites, and priests out into the cities of Judah. They carried the book of the law of the Lord with them. They taught the people. They did not just manage resources. They flooded the culture with truth. As a kingdom executive, your influence is your teaching tour. Your team does not just need another corporate policy. They need an environment shaped by grace, truth, and unshakable integrity. When the word of Christ dwells richly in your operations, fear departs. You stop seeing

employees as mere units of output. You see them as souls entrusted to your care. You build a workplace culture that mirrors the stability of heaven.

What happened next in the text is striking. The fear of the Lord fell on all the kingdoms around Judah. They did not make war against Jehoshaphat. Neighboring tribes even brought him tribute and silver. Obedience to God shifted the geopolitical atmosphere.



You cannot manipulate the market into peace. But you can steward your business with kingdom alignment. When your primary allegiance is to the King of kings, external pressures shift. Favor is a byproduct of faithfulness. You will notice that you stop panicking over competitor moves. You make decisions from rest, not panic. Profit becomes a tool for kingdom expansion, not just an idol for survival. Jehoshaphat grew greater and greater. He built fortresses and store cities. He had massive wealth and respect. Yet his strength was never in his gold. It was in his God. Your enterprise is designed to increase. It is designed to be strong, stable, and impactful. Let your business be a fortress of His goodness in a shifting economic landscape. Lead with a quiet, holy confidence today
