Deuteronomy 34:9

The Leadership Shift

In the corporate world, transitions cause panic. Stock prices drop when a visionary CEO steps down. Successor anxiety is real. Yet, Joshua stepped into leadership without fear. His confidence did not come from his own resume or corporate strategy. It came from an external source: a spirit of wisdom passed down through spiritual alignment.

When faced with a complex merger or a sudden financial crisis, your first instinct should not be panic. It should be alignment. The same wisdom that filled Joshua to conquer Canaan is available to you to conquer your industry. This wisdom alters how you negotiate, manage assets, and lead people. Kingdom execution requires merging operational excellence with spiritual sensitivity. You analyze the balance sheets, but you also listen to the still, small voice.
