



EXPANDING YOUR BUSINESS TERRITORY

"Command the Israelites and say to them: 'When you enter the land of Canaan, this is the land that will fall to you as an inheritance, its borders several times over.'" — Numbers 34:2 (paraphrased)

In Numbers 34, God did not just tell the Israelites they had a promised land. He gave them a detailed map with precise coordinates. He established clear borders for their success, growth, and security. As a new creation, your business and life are not meant to be chaotic and undefined. You have a divine inheritance of wisdom, creativity, and favor. But just like Israel, you have to be intentional about "mapping out" and taking possession of your spiritual and professional territory.



In business, mapping your territory means defining your core values, setting healthy boundaries against burnout, and identifying your ideal market. Boundaries are not limitations; they are definitions of your responsibility. When you clearly outline what is yours to steward—your

skills, your products, your team, and your clients—you know exactly where to focus your faith and energy. Furthermore, the Israelites were given Eleazar the priest and Joshua to divide the inheritance by sacred lot. This points to the New Covenant, where Christ is our High Priest and our "Joshua" (which means *Deliverer*). You do not have to conquer your market relying solely on your own human strength. You have the ultimate Business Partner. When you operate from the reality that you are a new creation, you do not work *for* victory; you work *from* a place of victory already secured for you. Take time today to define your "borders." What are the new projects God is calling you to explore? Where do you need to draw healthy professional boundaries? Claim your territory, write down your goals, and step boldly into the doors Christ has opened for you.



Practical Outcomes

1. **Define Your Vision and Borders:** Write down your primary business goals and the exact "territory" (target demographic, niche) you are serving this year.
2. **Audit Your Boundaries:** List three areas where you are losing energy (e.g., unprofitable tasks, scope creep) and set a strict boundary or system to eliminate them.
3. **Daily Strategic Focus:** Commit 15 minutes each morning to pray over your business goals and map out your daily tasks before engaging with distractions.
