God dismantled an entire empire to bring His people out. His ultimate goal was simple yet profound: to establish deep in their hearts that "the Lord Himself is God... there is no other." The world tells you that your performance defines your security. This mindset breeds constant anxiety, sleepless nights, and a defensive leadership style.
