Witness of the Word

"Behold, this stone shall be a witness unto us..."—Joshua 24:27

In 2019, a mid-sized logistics firm faced a defining moment. A major client discovered a billing discrepancy that favored the company by \$47,000. The error was subtle, unlikely to be audited, and legally defensible. The board convened. Some argued: "Keep it. We earned it through efficiency." Others hesitated.

The CEO, a born-again believer, opened his Bible to Joshua 24. The stone stood as a witness to Israel's covenant. What was witnessing in his company? He recalled Proverbs 11:1: "A false balance is an abomination to the Lord, but a just weight is his delight."

Under the New Covenant, righteousness is not earned—it is received. But that righteousness produces fruit. He chose to disclose the error, refund the full amount, and issue a written apology. The client was stunned. Within six months, that same client referred three new contracts worth \$2.3 million.

The stone witnessed. The Word proved faithful.

This is not prosperity gospel—it is covenant reality. When we operate from the New Creation nature, integrity is not a strategy; it is our identity. We do not chase favor; we walk in it. The stone heard the words of the Lord. Let your business do the same.

The witness stands. The Word prevails.

Covenant Consciousness in the Corporate Arena

The phrase "as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord" (Joshua 24:15) is often domesticated into family devotions. But Joshua spoke to a nation preparing to possess territory. This is conquest language. This is executive language.

In the New Covenant, we are not conquering land—we are redeeming systems. Every corporation, every startup, every marketplace platform is territory waiting for Kingdom influence. But influence requires consciousness. You cannot lead from what you do not carry.

Covenant consciousness means waking up each day knowing you are seated with Christ in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6). It means your boardroom decisions flow from rest, not striving. It means you negotiate from abundance, not scarcity. When crisis hits, you do not panic—you remember whose you are.

I have consulted for companies that collapsed under pressure because their foundation was performance. I have watched others thrive because their leaders understood: we are not fighting for victory; we are fighting from victory.

The stone Joshua erected was external. You are internal. The Holy Spirit is your witness, your guide, your seal. When you sign a contract, the Spirit witnesses. When you lead a team, the Spirit guides. When you face an ethical crossroad, the Spirit reminds: you are a New Creation.

Serve the Lord in your corporation. The stone is watching. The Word is faithful. And the Spirit is rising.

Business Case Study: Meridian Health Solutions (EA) Product Recall & Reputation Collapse (2022)

Meridian Health Solutions discovered a contamination risk in their flagship supplement line. The defect affected 15,000 units already in the market. Legal counsel advised a limited recall —only reported cases, no public announcement. The potential liability: \$4.2 million. The potential reputational damage: incalculable.

The Kingdom Response:

The founder, Pastor Elizabeth Mwangi, convened her leadership team for prayer. Three principles guided their decision:

1. Transparency Over Protection (Proverbs 28:13)

They announced a full public recall before any complaints surfaced. Press release led with: "Your safety is our covenant."

2. Restitution Over Minimization (Luke 19:8)

Every customer received a full refund plus a replacement product at no cost. No forms, no hurdles.

3. Accountability Over Blame (James 5:16)

The founder publicly acknowledged the failure, resigned from the industry board, and commissioned third-party audits.

The Outcome:

Short-term loss: \$5.8 million. Long-term gain: Customer loyalty increased 340%. Within 18 months, revenue surpassed pre-crisis levels by 67%. Industry regulators cited Meridian as the "gold standard for ethical recall management."

The Lesson:

Covenant principles are not liabilities—they are competitive advantages. The world protects reputation. The Kingdom protects people. And in the end, God protects those who honor Him.

The word "**covenant**" appears ****292 times**** in the Bible. The Hebrew word **"berith"** literally means **"to cut"**—referencing the ancient practice of cutting animals when making a solemn agreement. In the New Covenant, Christ was cut for us. We rest in His finished work.
